The petitioner is seeking regular bail by way of petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.185 dated 23.09.2022 registered under Sections 379-B, 34, 411 of the IPC registered at Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur.

2. Allegations are that on 10.09.2022, complainant Inderjit Kaur had gone to Mahilpur. As she was returning, two motorcyclist came at about 11:00 a.m., snatched her mobile phone make Oppo and fled away. Complaint was made to the police on 23.09.2022 resulting in registration of the FIR, in which complainant disclosed that she had been searching for the snatcher at her own and had come to know their names as petitioner Amandeep Singh and Amritpal Singh.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has pointed out that FIR has been lodged after delay of 13 days. Petitioner has not disclosed the source of

her information as to how she came to know about identity of the snatchers.

4. Notice of motion.
5. Mr. M.S. Nagra, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent- State.
6. Learned State counsel could not refute the aforesaid contentions as raised by counsel for the petitioner. Besides, learned State counsel also informs that after concluding the investigation challan has already been filed and that after framing of the charges 08 witnesses have already been examined out of 10 witnesses cited by the prosecution. It is further informed that petitioner is in custody since 24.09.2022 i.e. for the last more than one year.
7. Heard.
8. Having regard to the above facts and circumstances, but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
