Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 to 3, to provide protection of lives and liberty of the petitioners, which is threatened at the hands of private respondents No. 4 to 6 and their friends and relatives.

On 01.11.2022 following order was passed by the co-ordinate bench of this Court:

“Present: None.

*The petitioners are present in person. Photo copies
of their identity cards are taken on record. They wish to
live in safe house.*

*Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at
this stage.*

ASI Rishi Lal (AHTU), Sector 17, Chandigarh is

present in court. He undertakes to take the petitioners to Safe House, Panchkula from the court premises itself.

Put up on 2.12.2022.

In the meantime, the police officials not below the rank of Deputy Superintendent of Police should record the statements of the petitioners.”

In compliance of aforesaid order, status report by way of an affidavit of Ashok Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Headquarters Hisar, on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3, dated 19.11.2022 filed by State is already on record.

Registry is directed to tag the same at appropriate place.

As per said status report, now petitioners have no threat perception from any one, hence, they do not require any protection. Statement of both the petitioners have also been recorded in this regard and same are made part of the status report.

In view of the stand taken in the said status report, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks withdrawal of the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
