Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.142 dated 3.8.2022 registered under Sections 447, 511, 506, 379, 34 IPC at Police Station Sadar, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police in compliance of previous order passed by this Court. He further submits that the petitioner will abide by the undertaking given by him in this Court on the last date of hearing and will not interfere into possession of the complainant over the plot in question in future except in due course of law.

State counsel on instructions from ASI Major Singh apprised the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police and is not required for any further investigation or custodial interrogation by the police.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 13.1.2023_ is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and is also to abide by the undertaking given by the petitioner personally in this Court on 13.1.2023.
