Prayer in the present petition under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.261 dated 9.9.2022 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 364-A, 34, 506 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act at Police Station Civil Line, Jind.

Counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case and is in custody since 9.9.2022 and now compromise has been effected with the complainant and copy of the concerned affidavit is Annexure P-2.

Present petition is contested by the State counsel who on instructions from PSI Karamjit Singh apprised the Court that the challan has been presented by the police after completion of investigation but charges are yet to be framed and that the petitioner is in custody since 9.9.2022 and

that the petitioner is also involved in two other criminal cases.

Counsel for the complainant has admitted the factum of compromise and has not disputed the contents of affidavit Annexure P-2 which is executed by the complainant with regard to the compromise.

I have considered the submissions made by the counsel for the parties.

In view of above, as challan has been presented by the police and further, it appears that parties have entered into compromise and it will take time for conclusion of trial, no useful purpose is going to be served by keeping the petitioner in custody for any further period.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
