Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in criminal case having FIR No.176 dated 30.9.2022 registered under Sections 307, 34, 506 IPC and Section 8-B of National Highways Act at Police Station Naggal, District Ambala.

Counsel for the petitioners *inter alia* contends that the petitioners are falsely implicated in this case and now the matter has been compromised between the parties and further, the petitioners have joined the investigation with the police in compliance of previous order of interim bail passed by Coordinate Bench of this Court.

Counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant submits that indeed, parties have entered into compromise and he is having no objection

State counsel on instructions from ASI Pardeep Kumar submits that the petitioners who have joined the investigation with the police, are not required for any further investigation or custodial interrogation by the police.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 17.11.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
