The appellants herein are the objectors. They are the children of the judgment debtor. They claim to be in possession of the property. A decree for possession, by way of specific performance of the agreement to sell, has been passed against Salim, on 19.07.2014, which, in appeal, was affirmed by the First Appellate Court. The appellants have failed to establish any independent right in the property.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, there is no ground to interfere with the order passed by the Executing Court, while dismissing the objection petition filed by the appellants.

Hence, dismissed.
