Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of FIR No.26 dated 13.03.2019, registered for offences under Sections 420 and 406 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Nurpur Bedi, District Rupnagar, Annexure P-1, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of the compromise dated 30.05.2019, Annexure P-2, arrived at between the parties.
