The appellants have filed the present appeal under Section 14-A (2) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 (hereinafter referred to as the 'Act') against the impugned order dated 15.09.2023, passed by the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Sirsa in case FIR No.374 dated 22.08.2023 under Section 147/149/323/506 of IPC and under Section 3(1)(s) of the "Act" at Police Station Sadar, Sirsa, whereby the anticipatory bail petition filed by the present appellants was ordered to be dismissed.

Learned counsel for the appellants submit that in compliance of the order dated 19.10.2023 passed by this Court, the appellants have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel submits that the appellants have joined the investigation and are no longer required for further investigation.
