Prayer made in the present writ petition was for seeking quashing of the letter dated 26.06.2015 (Annexure P-3) issued by the Central Bureau of Investigation-respondent No.4 whereby the property of the petitioner has been seized.

Learned counsel appearing for the Central Bureau of Investigation-respondent No.4 has handed over today in Court a copy of Folio No.CBS/RCBD12014E0006-CBI/BSFB/Delhi dated 02.11.2023, as per which, it has been averred that since the investigation in the matter has been completed, therefore, any restriction imposed on the transfer

transactions of the above properties by virtue of the letter dated 26.06.2015 (under challenge herein) has been ordered to be lifted. The same is taken on record and marked as 'Mark-X.'

In view of aforesaid communication issued by the Central Bureau of Investigation-respondent No.4, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Disposed of accordingly.
