1. This petition is filed seeking regular bail in case of FIR No. 43, dated 24th April, 2021, under Section 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short 'the Act'), registered at Police Station Ghanaur, District Patiala.

2. One of the main ground for seeking bail is that trial is not proceeding at a decent pace.

3. Learned State counsel on instructions submits that out of total ten prosecution witnesses three have been examined and an earnest effort would be made to examine the remaining prosecution witnesses within six months from the date fixed before the trial Court.

4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the State, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition at this stage.

5. Dismissed as withdrawn.

6. There is no doubt that in case a request is made before the court concerned for accommodating the date for examining the prosecution witnesses, the same would be considered in accordance with law.
