This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction especially in the nature of mandamus directing respondent no.3 to grant the regular timings to the petitioner to operate its route permit which had been granted to the petitioner despite the fact that the petitioner is holder of valid Stage Carriage Permit No.47/Reg/SC/RTA/BTI/22 issued on 3.3.2022 (Annexure P-1) on the route Barnala to Talwandi via Mansa.

2. Learned State counsel on instructions from Sh. Rahul Kumar Sharma, Senior Legal Assistant office of S.T.C has submitted that the needful has been done and the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has affirmed the above statement and has submitted that the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
