JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J.

The prayer in the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case registered against her vide FIR No.0145 dated 01.09.2022 under Sections 379-B, 323, 342, 506, 149 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Punjab Agricultural University (PAU), District Ludhiana.

The learned counsel for the State on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 17.11.2022.

It has been brought to the notice of this Court that a cancellation report has been submitted before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana and the same is pending adjudication for 19.08.2023.

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In view of the above, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is ordered to be disposed of at this stage. However, in case the cancellation report is not accepted or a further investigation is ordered or the petitioner apprehends her arrest, she is at liberty to file a fresh petition for the grant of anticipatory bail.

The presence of the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana is dispensed with accordingly.
