For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and the submissions i.e. *“He submitted that it is a case where there were two firms namely, M/s Modern Lace House and M/s Parshwa Accessories Pvt. Ltd. In the aforesaid M/s Modern Lace House one Sachit Jain was having 51% share and in the M/s Parshwa Accessories Pvt. Ltd., he was holding 42% share whereas the petitioner Ankur Jain was holding 5% share, Sarita was holding 2% share and HUF was having marginal share”* made in order dated 01.12.2022 be read as submissions made by learned counsel for the complainant instead of submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.614 dated 01.09.2022 registered under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 506 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Kundli, Sonipat.

Learned State counsel, on instructions of ASI Sandeep Singh, submits that in pursuance of order dated 01.12.2022 passed

by the Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 01.12.2022 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
