The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.02 dated 27.11.2020 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC, 1860 (Section 120-B IPC, 1860 added later on) at Police Station Punjab State Crime Police, SAS Nagar, District SAS Nagar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 31.10.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A short reply dated 07.12.2023 by way of an affidavit of Narinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, State Crime, Phase-4 SAS Nagar has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 31.10.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
