CM-9555-C-2022

Present application has been filed for disposal of the main appeal as per compromise Annexure A-1.

Notice of the application was already issued to the counsel opposite.

Learned counsel for the respondents raises no objection for the grant of prayer as raised in the present application.

Keeping in view the above, the application is allowed.

On joint request of learned counsel for the parties, the main appeal is taken up for hearing today itself.

RSA-242-2014

Learned counsel for the parties submits that the parties have already entered into compromise to settle their dispute and the present Regular Second Appeal be disposed of in terms of the said compromise dated 08.12.2022 by invoking jurisdiction under Order 23 Rule 1 of the CPC.

Learned counsel for the appellant submits that Baljit Singh as well as Jeet Kaur @ Manjit Kaur signed the compromise on 08.12.2022.

Paramjit Kaur has also filed an affidavit stating that the agreement entered

into between Baljit Singh and Jeet Kaur @ Manjit Kaur is acceptable to her. The parties have already placed on record the said affidavit for the perusal of the Court.

Even today, at the bar, learned counsel for the parties reiterate their stand that the parties have already settled their dispute amicably and the present Regular Second Appeal be disposed of in terms of the agreement dated 08.12.2022 signed between Baljit Singh and Jeet Kaur @ Manjit Kaur and heirs of Gursewak Singh, which agreement has duly been approved and accepted by Bir Kaur @ Paramjit Kaur vide her affidavit dated 15.02.2023.

Keeping in view the said un-disputed stand of the parties concerned, the present Regular Second Appeal is disposed of in terms of agreement dated 08.12.2022 with all just exceptions and the decree sheet be prepared accordingly.
