Petitioner has assailed the order dated 19.05.2022 passed by the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Jalandhar in the case bearing FIR No.13 dated 30.01.2019, under Sections 307/324/148/149 IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Basti Bawa Khel, District Jalandhar.

In terms of the impugned order, the bail of the petitioner was cancelled, bail bonds and surety bonds are forfeited to the State and he was summoned through non-bailable warrants on account of his absence during the course of proceedings.

On 04.11.2022, the following order was passed:-

In view of resolution of the Bar, the lawyers are abstaining from work.

Prayer in this petition is for setting aside the order dated 19.05.2022 passed by the trial Court, vide which bail/surety bonds of the petitioner were forfeited and non-bailable warrants have been issued.

It is stated in the petition that a compromise has already been effected between the parties, in which petitioner Lovelpreet Singh is also a party and on a previous occasion, CRM-M-45813-2019 was filed by the petitioner and others, which was disposed of on 16.03.2022. Reliance is also placed on the order dated 26.03.2021 passed in CRM-M-25047-2019, vide which

same FIR i.e. FIR No.13 dated 30.01.2019 under Sections 326-A, 120-B, 34 IPC, registered at Police Cantt. Jalandhar, District Police Commissionerate Jalandhar stands quashed against four persons namely Gurdeep Singh, Jaswinder Singh, Money and Preet @ Bhinder Singh @ Shanty.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court within a period of 15 days from today and he will be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing fresh bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of interim directions, the petitioner had appeared before the learned trial Court and has been released on interim bail.

On instructions from ASI Jaswinder Singh, learned State counsel has not disputed the factual aspects.

In these circumstances, the order granting interim bail to the petitioner in terms of order dated 04.11.2022 is made absolute.

Petition is accordingly disposed of.
