The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0136 dated 19.08.2023 under Sections 353, 186, 341, 323, 379, 148, 149, 506 and 427 IPC and Section 3 of Public Property (Prevention of Damage) Act 1985, registered at P.S. District Sadar Bathinda.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 06.10.2023 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 06.10.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 06.10.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
