On October 03, 2023, the following order was passed in this
case:-

“The Prayer in this petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for the quashing of the order dated 23.08.2023 (Annexure P-2) whereby the bail of the petitioner has been wrongly cancelled by JMIC, Ambala in complaint no.837 dated 19.04.2018 under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881.

The Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was unable to appear on 28.03.2023 on which date an application for exemption had been moved. However, the same had been declined. Thereafter, the petitioner had applied for the grant of anticipatory bail which came to be disposed of with the directions to the petitioner to surrender before the Trial Court within 10 days and seek regular bail. He states that he is ready and willing to join the proceedings once again.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the Trial Court within a period of one week from today and subject to a deposit of Rs.50,000/- as costs with the Shree Shiv Kanwar Mahasangh Charitable Trust (Regd.), # 36A, Near Gugga Marhi Mandhir, Maheshpur, Sector 21, Panchkula, Haryana Account No.55020100001119, IFSC BARBOMDCPAN(0-ZERO) Bank of Baroda, Swastik Vihar, Panchkula, he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the Trial Court.

The petitioner is further directed to place on record the photocopy of receipt of payment as well as the order passed by the court below granting interim bail to the petitioner.”

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance to the aforementioned order, the petitioner has surrendered before the Court of the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ambala and has since been admitted to interim bail as is borne out from the order dated 06.10.2023. A copy of the said order is taken on record as Mark ‘A’.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court. Disposed of.

It is expected that the petitioner shall henceforth not absent himself from the Trial but for a sufficient cause.
