1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent to correct her date of birth in the passport.

2. The petitioner was issued passport No.R3723100 on 04.10.2017 which is valid upto 13.10.2027. In the passport date of birth of the petitioner has been recorded as 18.02.1985 whereas as per petitioner correct date of birth is 18.02.1984. The petitioner has filed an application before the passport authority seeking correction of her date of birth. The grievance of the petitioner is that respondent is not paying heed to the request of the petitioner.

3. Mr. Karan Singh, Advocate who on advance notice is present in Court submits that competent authority would look into the grievance of the petitioner and pass an appropriate order within 6 weeks

from today.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner agrees with aforesaid arrangement.

5. In the wake of statements of both sides, the petition stands disposed of.
