1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case bearing FIR No.150 dated 18.02.2019 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Nuh, District Nuh (Haryana).

2. Vide order dated 07.12.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 07.12.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such her interim bail may be made absolute. The learned State counsel, on instructions from Investigating Officer, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and her custodial interrogation in the present case is not required, however, she may be directed to remain present as and when required by the Investigating Officer in the present

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case.

4. In view of the above, interim order dated 07.12.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C and the petitioner shall remain present as and when required by the Investigating Officer in the present case.

5. The present petition stands disposed of.
