1. Prayer in this writ petition is for setting aside sale notice dated 09.09.2019 (Annexure P-4).
2. Learned counsel for respondent-Bank while referring to reply dated 07.11.2023 submits that this writ petition is rendered infructuous as loan account of petitioners has been settled and stands closed on 24.08.2020.
3. Perusal of file reveals that none has been appeared on behalf of petitioners since 26.02.2020.
4. Keeping in view the categorical statement made on behalf of respondent-Bank, we find no justification for continuance of present proceedings.

5. Writ petition is accordingly disposed of as infructuous. Liberty is afforded to the petitioners to file appropriate application within four weeks in case any incorrect fact has been placed before us.
