By way of present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C, the
petitioners seek anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under: -

FIR No.	Dated	Sections	Police Station
17	16.01.2023	136 of Electricity Act	Narnaund, District Hissar.

2. Status report dated 16.10.2023 in the form of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Narnaund, has been filed. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance to the order dated 04.10.2023, both the petitioners have joined investigation and as such prayed for confirming the interim bail granted to the petitioner on the basis of the reply submitted by learned State counsel. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners have joined investigation on 09.10.2023 in compliance to the order dated

04.10.2023 and the possible recoveries has been effected. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners are not required for further investigation in the case.

4. Learned State counsel has intimated that the petitioners have joined investigation and is no more required for any custodial investigation in this case nor he is required for further investigation.

5. After hearing the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel, it transpires that the petitioners were granted concession of interim bail in the FIR (Annexure P-1) and were directed to join investigation vide order dated 04.10.2023 passed by this Court.

6. As stated above, the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for further investigation in this case. Therefore, in these circumstances, without commenting on the merits of the case, interim bail granted vide order dated 04.10.2023 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C., that the petitioners will come and join the investigation as and when so required; will not tamper with the evidence and will not leave the country without prior permission and will appear in Court on each and every date of hearing.

7. The petition stands allowed.
