Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case having FIR No.10
dated 8.12.2021 registered under Sections 420, 120-B IPC at Police Station
NRI Sangrur, District Sangrur.

The counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has
joined investigation with the police by virtue of previous order of interim
bail passed by this Court and further the matter has been compromised

between the parties and boy & girl have already filed joint petition under Section of 13-B HMA for grant of divorce by way of mutual consent.

State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurjant Singh apprised the Court that the petitioners who have joined investigation are not required by police for further investigation or for custodial interrogation.

The counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant has admitted that now matter has been settled between the parties and divorce petition has been filed under Section 13-B of HMA on the basis of settlement.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby allowed and order dated 5.1.2022 is hereby made absolute. The petitioner should abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
