Petition herein *inter alia* is for issuance of directions to official respondents to conduct free and fair investigation in a time bound manner in FIR No.243 dated 03.05.2023 registered for offence punishable under Sections 148, 149, 323 IPC and Sections 506 & 302 IPC (added later on).

Counsel for the petitioner does not dispute that so far as the investigation is concerned the report under Section 173(2) of the Code already stands filed and if there is any grievance of the petitioner the same can be resorted to by invoking Section 173(8) of the Code.

So far as the protection of life and liberty of petitioner and his family is concerned, learned State counsel submits that respondent No.3 shall take into consideration the apprehended threat and act accordingly.

Needless to say that assessment of apprehension of threat is purely within the domain of the parties and statement made by counsel as recorded herein above cannot be read to enure necessary benefit to the

petitioner.

Petition stands disposed off accordingly.
