Present writ petition has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.1 & 2 for taking suitable action against respondent No.5 under the provisions of Section 16(e) of Punjab Municipal Act, 1911.

It has been contended by learned counsel for respondent No.4 that the petition was filed praying for taking action against respondent No.5, however, term of respondent No.5 has already expired in March 2020 and thus, this petition has been rendered infructuous.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for respondent No.4, the present petition is disposed of as infructuous. However, the petitioners are at liberty to pursue their further remedies in accordance with law. In view of the facts and circumstances of this case, cost of Rs.1 lac deposited by the petitioners in compliance of order dated 16.10.2019 be refunded to the petitioners forthwith.
