On the last date of hearing i.e. 30.11.2023, the following
order was passed:-

“The instant revision petition has been preferred by the petitioners under Artcile 227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate direction to the learned trial Court to decide the civil suit of the petitioners expeditiously, in accordance with law.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that written statement to the civil suit was filed on 21.09.2022 and the case was adjourned for 29.11.2022 for arguments. He further submits that the trial of the suit is proceeding at the same stage, even after a lapse of 01 year. He has referred to the zimini orders dated 21.09.2022, 23.11.2022, 16.12.2022, 23.02.2023, 18.04.2023, 24.05.2023, 17.07.2023, 19.08.2023 and 19.10.2023. He also submits that the matter is now listed on 05.12.2023 for arguments.

Let status report be called for from the concerned Court with regard to the progress made in trial of Civil Suit No.366 of 2022, through the learned District & Sessions Judge, Chandigarh on or before the next date of hearing.

Adjourned to 18.12.2023.”

Status report dated 16.12.2023, has been received from the
learned Civil Judge (Jr. Division), Chandigarh, which reads as under:-

“It is humbly submitted that vide order dated 06.12.2023, the application under Order 39 Rule 1 &2 r/w Section 151 of CPC was decided. Vide order dated 12.12.2023, the application for seeking indulgence of the Court to apprise the SDO, Electricity, OP Sub-Division 9, Sector 43, Chandigarh was decided. Vide order dated 12.12.2023, issues were framed in the present case and it has been listed on 22.12.2023 for the evidence of the plaintiff. The requisite report is submitted accordingly.”

Since the matter is further proceeding before the said Court, no further orders are called for in the present case.
