1. The petitioners are seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. to join the proceedings before the Trial Court in PC/10/2022 and PC/11/2022 in case FIR No.RCHG2019A0016 dated 04.11.2019 under Sections 120-B, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 472 of the IPC and Section 13(2) read with Section 13(1)(D) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, registered at Police Station CBI, ACB, CHB Chandigarh.

2. On 05.10.2023, a Coordinate Bench of this Court had granted the interim bail to the petitioners and asked them to appear before the Trial Court.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of order dated 05.10.2023, the petitioners appeared before the Trial Court and have since submitted their bail bonds, and thereafter granted interim bail. In support, learned counsel has filed copies of

order dated 17.10.2023 and 19.10.2023 of the learned Trial Court, which are taken on record subject to all just exceptions.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the respondent-CBI does not dispute the factum of the petitioners having appeared before the Trial Court and thereafter granted interim bail.

5. In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 05.10.2023, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
