The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 73 dated 17.06.2021 under Sections 21 & 25 of NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Tappa Mandi, District Barnala.

No ground for grant of regular bail to the petitioner is made out.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

The petitioner is seeking interim bail for a period of four weeks to make arrangements for the marriage of her daughter and also to attend the same as it is to take place on 10.12.2023.

In compliance of the order dated 01.12.2023 affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Tapa, District Barnala on behalf of State of Punjab filed in Court is taken on record subject to all just exceptions.

Learned State counsel has drawn the attention of this Court to paragraph No. 3 of the affidavit and submitted that the marriage of the eldest daughter of the petitioner namely Anju is indeed due to be solemnized on 10.12.2023 at Om Banquet, Barnala. However, learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioner is a man of criminal antecedents and he is involved in 06 cases under the NDPS Act and 01 case under the Excise Act. It has also been submitted that the trial in the case in hand is nearing conclusion as the prosecution evidence stands concluded and it is now fixed for recording of statements of the accused under Section 313 Cr.P.C.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the material on record.

5 The marriage of the daughter of the petitioner is to take place on 10.12.2023. His presence would be necessary to perform ceremonies in connection with the marriage. Consequently, the petitioner be taken to the venue of the marriage on 10.12.2023 for participating in the various ceremonies. The petitioner shall be escorted at 8:30 am under the custody of the police and return the same day at 5:30 pm; the expenditure for the same shall be borne by the petitioner.

7. Application stands disposed of.
