The prayer in the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of writ, order or direction directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect the life and personal liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 6.

A short reply dated 20.11.2023 by way of an affidavit of Darpan Ahluwalia, Assistant Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division, Dera Bassi, District SAS Nagar has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. While referring to the reply, he contends that the statement of petitioner No.1 has been recorded wherein she has stated that she willingly solemnized marriage with Deepak Saini (petitioner No.2) and though the parents were unhappy with the said marriage, she does not face any threat from her parental family members and they are visiting terms. The statement of petitioner No.1 has been duly verified by petitioner No.2.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.
