The petitioners are seeking directions qua respondent No. 2 to list/take up/adjudicate the petitions/ applications preferred (during 15.09.2021 to 29.03.2022) as per Annexure P-1 under the provisions of Prevention of Money Laundering Act in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has referred to the orders passed by this Court in CWP-4207-2022, CWP-11576-2023 and CWP-20301-2023 (Annexures P-2 to P-4) whereby the said petitions have been disposed of by giving direction to respondents to pass appropriate orders on the applications for provisional release of the properties of the petitioners as they are the bonafide purchasers.

This petition is being disposed of, at this stage, by giving direction to respondent No. 2 to decide applications received by them as per the details of the properties given in Annexure P-1 in accordance with law within a period of three months.
