VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

This is a civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction especially in the nature of mandamus for directing the official respondents to transfer and incorporate the ownership of the residential property in the name of the petitioner in the revenue record on the basis of registered Will dated 22.04.2022.

On 06.12.2022, a coordinate Bench of this Court had directed the learned State counsel to get instructions and in pursuance of the same, he has submitted that the petitioner has not shown any document of ownership in the name of his father nor the same has been annexed with the present petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that in view of the same, he seeks to withdraw the present petition, at this stage, with liberty to approach the authorities along with documents of ownership and the other documents which are necessary.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn at this stage with the aforesaid liberty.
