By way of present petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners are seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 to 10.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Gaurav Bansal, D.A.G., Haryana appears and accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

4. Both the petitioners have claimed themselves to be major relying upon their Aadhar Cards indicating that petitioner No.1-Parvinder is 1990 born and petitioner No.2-Anju is 2002 born.

5. Without commenting on merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to direct respondent No.2 (Superintendent of Police, Jind) to look into the representation dated 22.09.2023 (Annexure P-5) submitted by petitioners. Ordered accordingly.

6. Keeping in view the fact and circumstances of the case, I think that if possible, respondent No.2 may call a meeting of the petitioners as well as respondents No.4 to 10 in his presence, so that the parties get rid off their ill feelings and live amicably.
7. Petition stands disposed off.
8. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
