1. Case taken up at the mentioning of learned counsel for the petitioner.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous as during the pendency of the present petition, the criminal complaint titled as ‘Sanjeev Kumar vs. Parveen Kumari etc.’ registered under Sections 307, 120-B and 34 IPC and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom have been quashed vide order dated 17.5.2023 passed in CRM-M-39273-2022, by this Court. Pursuant thereto, all the accused have been set at liberty vide order dated 05.07.2023 passed by the trial Court.
