1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking direction to respondents to grant benefit of 30 days pay structure in view of order dated 28.03.2023 (Annexure P-2) passed by Chief Engineer, Project Sampark. The respondent is paying wages for 26 days in a month whereas as per order dated 28.03.2023 (Annexure P-2) the petitioners are entitled to wages of complete month i.e. 30/31 days.
2. Mr. Shivoy Dhir, Advocate, who on advance notice is present in Court on behalf of the respondents, submits that respondents would consider claim of the petitioners in the light of order dated 28.03.2023 (Annexure P-2) and pass an appropriate order within 6 weeks from today.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners agrees to the said arrangement.

4. In the wake of statements of learned counsels for the parties, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondents to pass an appropriate order within 6 weeks from today.

It is made clear that present petition would be treated as representation of the petitioner.
