The petitioners have filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus to direct the respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, as they apprehend threats at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7.

A status report by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Phul, District Bathinda has been filed on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 and the same is taken on record.

Learned State counsel submits that in the present case one FIR No. 195 dated 18.09.2023, under Section 363,363-A, Police Station City, Rampura, District Bathinda has been registered against the petitioner No.2 on the statement made by respondent No.4. Even the petitioner No.1 has been shifted to Sakhi Centre, Bathinda for safe custody. He further submits that the

petitioner No.2 is found involved in the crime and necessary action shall be taken against him, in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, nothing survives in the present petition and the petition is accordingly, disposed off.
