SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (Oral)

This is the third petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short “the Code”) seeking grant of regular bail in FIR No.95 dated 10.09.2018, registered for offences under Sections 302, 34, 109 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Sadar Rampura, District Bathinda, Annexure P-1.

Custody Certificate dated 21.03.2023 has been filed by the State, which is taken on record.

During the course of arguments, it has transpired that the prosecution has concluded its evidence and the statement of the accused under Section 313 of the Code has been recorded.

Counsel for the complainant submits that despite three adjournments, the defence has failed to produce any witness.

Considering the advance stage of the trial, this Court is not inclined to accept the prayer made in the petition.

Petition is dismissed.
