The prayer in the criminal writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for the release of detenues as mentioned in para no.2 of the writ petition from the illegal custody of respondent nos.4 & 5.

None has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

The Counsel for the State has filed reply by way of affidavit of Mr. "Sushil Sarwan District Magistrate, Panchkula in court today which is taken on record. While referring to the said reply he contends that none of the alleged detenues referred to in the petition were found at the spot. Certain other labourers stated that they were residing there at their own free will.

by this Court.
