Prayer is for grant for anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case having FIR No.118 dated 22.09.2022 registered under Sections 384, 506, 149 of IPC, Police Station Longowal, District Sangrur.

The counsel for the petitioner inter alia submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police and recovery of car used in commission of alleged crime is effected.

The State counsel on instructions from ASI Ram Singh has apprised the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is cooperating with the police and got effected recovery of swift car used in commission of crime and now the petitioner is not required for any further investigation or custodial interrogation by the police.

In light of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order granting interim bail

dated 17.11.2022 passed by this Court to the petitioner is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
