The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.476 dated 13.08.2022 registered under Sections 147, 149, 294, 323, 341, 427 and 506 IPC at Police Station Palla, District Faridabad.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 21.11.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Lokesh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 21.11.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
