Present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking anticipatory bail in a case bearing FIR No.67 dated 04.05.2022 under Sections 307/323/341/148/149 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Division No.2, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.

Vide order dated 21.11.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 21.11.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. The learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Didar Singh has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 09.01.2023 and his further investigation in the present case is not required.

In view of the above, interim order dated 21.11.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The present petition stands disposed off.
