By way of present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C, the
petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under: -

FIR No.	Dated	Sections	Police Station
187	09.09.2023	323, 341, 452, 506 and 34 of IPC	Samrala, Police District Khanna.

2. Status report dated 18.10.2023 in the form of an affidavit of
Deputy Superintendent of Police, Samrala, Police District Khanna, District
Ludhiana, has been filed. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof has
been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance
to the order dated 05.10.2023, the petitioner has already joined
investigation and as such prayed for confirming the interim bail granted to
the petitioner on the basis of the reply submitted by learned State counsel.
Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has
joined investigation on 07.10.2023 in compliance to the order dated

05.10.2023 and the possible recoveries has been effected. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation in the case.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harjinder, has intimated that the petitioner has joined investigation and is no more required for any custodial investigation in this case nor he is required for further investigation.

5. After hearing the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel, it transpires that the petitioner was granted concession of interim bail in the FIR (Annexure P-1) and was directed to join investigation vide order dated 05.10.2023 passed by this Court.

6. As stated above, the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation in this case. Therefore, in these circumstances, without commenting on the merits of the case, interim bail granted vide order dated 05.10.2023 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C., that the petitioners will come and join the investigation as and when so required; will not tamper with the evidence and will not leave the country without prior permission and will appear in Court on each and every date of hearing.

7. The petition stands allowed.
