The instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondent to release the outstanding death benefits of his late father up to date along with interest to present petitioner and to decide the representation dated 09.06.2023 in time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the petitioners confines himself to the limited prayer for deciding the representation dated 09.06.2023 (Annexure P-4) served by the peittioners upon respondent No.1, expeditiously by passing a speaking order within a time bound manner.

In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, requirement of issuing notice to the respondents is dispensed with and at this stage, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioners in the representation dated 09.06.2023 (Annexure P-4), respondent No.1 is directed to decide the representation, by passing a

speaking order within a period of 8 weeks from the date of receipt of certified

copy of this order with a further direction that if the petitioners are found to be entitled to the claim mentioned in the abovesaid representation, necessary disbursement of funds shall be made to them within a period of 8 weeks thereafter.

Present petition is disposed of accordingly.
