Instant petition has been preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking directions to respondent No. 2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and dispose of the representation dated 10.08.2023 (Annexure P-4), in an expeditious manner.

2. It is, *inter alia*, submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that feeling aggrieved by the acts and conduct of the private respondents No. 5 to 9 and apprehending threats to their life and liberty, the petitioners had moved a representation dated 10.08.2023 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa, District Mansa. But no action till date has been taken thereon.

After hearing the respective submissions; considering the averments made in the petition and without commenting on the merits thereon, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa, District Mansa, to consider the averments made in the representation dated 10.08.2023 (Annexure P-4) and dispose of the same in an expeditious manner under the provisions of the law.
