RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 20.12.2018 passed in CWP-4852-2015.
2. It is not even in dispute that the petitioners have already gone in the execution process qua the decree referred to in the order, qua which the contempt is asserted. Since the remedy of execution has already been availed by the petitioners, therefore, this Court does not find it appropriate to continue with the contempt petition.
3. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
