The petitioner alleges violation of the order dated 03.12.2018, passed by this Court in CWP-30544-2018, vide which, it was directed that the claim of the petitioner will be decided within a period of three months by passing a speaking order and if it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefits, the same will be released to him within a period of three month thereafter.

As per affidavit of the Executive Engineer, Operation Division, UHBVN, Gohana, Sonapat, which is on record, it is stated that the order of the writ Court is completely complied with by passing a speaking order dated 01.03.2019. It is stated in the speaking order that since the commutation of pension was not claimed by the petitioner, the same cannot be granted to him, however, pension has already been released as per PPO dated 26.07.2011 and gratuity was also released on 26.07.2011.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered

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infructuous.

Rule stands discharged.

The petitioner is granted liberty to avail the alternative remedy,
in accordance with law, if so advised.
