Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of directions to the respondents to restore the mini drain by excavated which was previously connected to the Drain No.8 and part of the Mini Drain has been mixed with the cultivated land by farmers and they are sowing it and merged the mini drain with their agricultural land dug by government. Further prayer has been made directing the respondents to take appropriate action for dewatering the flood water from the field of the petitioners and taking action against the farmers who mixed the land of mini drain in their field dig by government.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that for the redressal of their grievances, petitioners have served a legal notice dated 21.08.2023 (Annexure P-34) upon the respondents but the same has not been taken into consideration by the said respondents till date.

After hearing counsel for the parties and perusing the record, respondent No.4-Sub Divisional Canal Officer, Gohana Water Services, Sub-Division Gohana, District Sonapat is directed to decide the legal notice dated 21.08.2023 (Annexure P-34) served by the petitioners expeditiously preferably within a period of four weeks from today in accordance with law.
