SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (Oral)

1. Instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect the life and personal liberty of petitioner No.1 and her friend, namely, Lovepreet Singh, petitioner No.2, by providing adequate police protection to them and also directing private respondents No.4 and 5 not to interfere in their personal life and liberty.
2. Concededly, petitioner No.1 is married to one Sarwan Singh, though a petition seeking divorce by mutual consent is pending. Petitioner No.2 is married to respondent No.4. Both the petitioners are living together. Relationship between the parties is not only illegal, but also immoral. This Court is not inclined to protect such a relationship.
3. At this stage, counsel for the petitioner seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the petition.
3. Dismissed as withdrawn, at this stage.
