SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (Oral)

1. Anmol Son of Sh. Mukesh Kumar (petitioner No.1) claims to be 18 years of age and Chandni daughter of Sh. Rohan Sahni (petitioner No.2) claims to be 18 years of age. They have pleaded that they are in live-in relationship against the wishes of respondents No. 4 to 8. They apprehend danger from them and seek protection to their life and liberty.

2. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 26.09.2023 Annexure P-3 to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District SAS Nagar (Mohali), Punjab.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has relied upon a judgment of Division Bench of this Court in CWP No.31834 of 2019 titled as ***“Megha and another vs. State of Haryana and others”*** decided on 04.11.2019 and submitted that this Court had entertained petition for protection of couples in live-in relationship.

4. Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation of the petitioners, Annexure P-3 and grant them protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law if any committed by them.
