1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to consider application of the petitioner for allotment of paddy for KMS 2023-24.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the petitioner leased out his mill to M/s Shiv Kripa Rice Mill who defaulted in the supply of rice to respondents. The lessee has cleared all the dues of the State still petitioner has not been allotted paddy. In 2021, DFSC, Kurukshetra, recommended allotment of paddy to petitioner to the extent of 50%.
3. Learned State counsel submits that competent authority, within 3 days from today, would pass an appropriate order on the representation dated 16.09.2023 (Annexure P-7) of the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner agrees to the aforesaid arrangement.

5. In the wake of statements of learned counsels for the parties, the present petition stands disposed of.

6. The respondents while passing order shall consider the factum of clearance of dues by lessee of the petitioner. If the lessee has cleared dues, the case of the petitioner shall be positively considered.
