This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction especially in the nature of mandamus seeking necessary directions to the respondent authorities for deciding the representation dated 23.11.2022 (Annexure P-2) and grant him extension in service after his date of superannuation on 30.09.2023 as per prevalent Government norms and Rules.
